What is library?

- > Everyone can use the library <u>free of charge</u>
- Library is a safe place to spend time.
- Library is a peaceful place for reading and studying.
 Please be respectful of other people when you
 visit the library.



- You can read books and magazines in the library.
- > You can borrow them and take them home with you for free.
- You can also borrow CDs, DVDs and audiobooks.
- > You can find material in several different languages.
- > You can use the computer and surf the Internet.
- You can take copies and print material at small cost
- ➤ The library provides services for people of all ages (children, adults, seniors).
- ➤ There are story hours for small children
- > Free movies for children and adults
- > Different happenings for free





Some rules:

- The standard loan period for books is 4 weeks.
- > For "most wanted" novelties 2 weeks.
- Magazines, CDs, DVDs, digital games also 4 weeks
- You will receive a receipt for the material you borrow.
 The receipt shows the material you checked out and the due date when it must be returned.
- ➤ If you return your loans late you must pay small overdue fine
- If you damage the material you will have to compensate it.
- You can renew your loans online or by visiting or calling the library
- ➤ You will need your PIN (Personal Identification Number) if you wish to log in the Ratamo libraries online service. You can have the PIN from the library.
